



HISTORY

The Association of Pacific Rim Universities was established in 1997 with leading universities across the Americas, Asia and Australasia, to contribute to the development of an increasingly integrated Pacific Rim community.

APRU began with 34 charter members with the declaration:

"The objective of this association of chief executive officers of premier universities around the Pacific Rim is to help these institutions become more effective contributors to the development of an increasingly integrated Pacific Rim community."

The first annual meeting of presidents took place in Los Angeles from June 1 to 3, 1997.



09:30 - 10:20 Zhejiang University to Fei Lai Feng

10:20 - 12:00 Fei Lai Feng

Fei Lai Feng stands next to Temple of Soul's Retreat (Lingyin Temple) and is a must-see in Hangzhou. There are many legends about the peak's name that we will learn about on our tour.

12:00 - 13:00 **Ou Xiang Ju**

13:00 - 13:40 **Su Di**

Su Di was built in the fifth year of Yuanyou Period in the Northern Song Dynasty (1090). Su Shi Dongpo, a well-known poet, built SUDI from dredged silt from West Lake. To commemorate Su Dongpo's achievements in controlling the West Lake, it was named "Su Di."

13:40 - 15:00 **Gu Shan**

Gu Shan is situated at the northwestern corner of West Lake. It is 38 meters above sea level and covers an area of 300 mu (nearly 50 acres). It is the biggest, and only natural, island in the lake.

15:00 - 16:00 **He Fang Street**

HE FANG STREET showcases a variety of Chinese crafts, such as hand-blown sugar candy, paper-cutting and hand-made dough figurines. Charming and lively, it is full of art hawkers, candy sculptors, pillow shops, caricaturists, old-fashioned movie players, storytellers, bonsai shops, teahouses, and an array of small eateries.
